

June 2008 Update
U.S. TAG for ISO/TC 197, Hydrogen technologies

1. Meetings

The U.S. TAG for ISO/TC 197 meeting was held on Friday, May 30, 2008, at CGA in Chantilly, Virginia. The primary purpose for this TAG meeting was to prepare for the ISO/TC 197 meeting in Brisbane, Australia, June 13, 2008. Glenn Scheffler and Karen Hall will be the U.S. delegates at this meeting.

2. Recently closed vote

- **ISO/FDIS 22734-1**, *Hydrogen generators using water electrolysis process—Part 1: Industrial and commercial applications*
The ballot concluded on May 28, 2008.
U.S. TAG vote approved with comments.

3. Currently out for vote

- **ISO/DIS 15869.3**, *Gaseous hydrogen and hydrogen blends—Land vehicle fuel tank*
At our request, the ballot was extended from 2 to 5 months.
U.S. TAG comments are due on July 2, 2008, so that we can review the comments and establish a position before the ballot closes on August 26, 2008.

- **ISO/DIS 16110-2**, *Hydrogen generators using fuel processing technologies—Part 2: Procedures to determine efficiencies*
U.S. TAG comments are due by July 14, 2008.
The ballot concludes September 11, 2008.

4. Participation on working group

Experts are needed to serve on ISO/TC 197/WG 5 on the revision of ISO 17268:2006, *Compressed hydrogen surface vehicle refueling connection devices*

The working group has been reactivated and the U.S. TAG is looking for experts who want to participate.

The next meeting of WG 5 will be in the Munich area July 29-30, 2008.
