V. Codes and Standards Organization Updates

IEC TC 105 Kelvin Hecht

The plenary meeting will be from November 6-10. This will be the first time that no US delegation is attending, due to the Fuel Cell Seminar occurring on the same week. Kelvin will follow the meeting electronically and report on any decisions made at the meeting.

Working Group 2 (Fuel Cell Module Standard) has posted a committee draft for the 3rd edition on the TC 105 website. Comments can be submitted until November 10. A joint US-Canadian task force is meeting to bring this standard into North America.

Working Group 3 (Stationary Standard) is waiting for a French translation to go out for a vote in the next couple of weeks.
